



REDUCE YOUR FEDERAL INCOME TAX WITH **ENERGY SAVING** HOME IMPROVEMENTS

Your tax bill can be cut by 30 percent of costs paid or incurred to modify your primary residence, limited to a total of \$1,500. Items to consider include:

- 1.** Insulation
- 2.** Exterior windows and doors (including storm windows, storm doors and skylights)
- 3.** Metal or asphalt roofs
- 4.** Central air conditioners
- 5.** Electric heat pumps
- 6.** Electric heat pump water heaters
- 7.** Water heaters using natural gas, oil or propane
- 8.** Natural gas, oil or propane furnaces (and related advanced main air circulating fans) and hot water boilers

In some cases, the \$1,500 limitation and primary residence requirement do not apply. Examples of property include equipment that utilizes:

- 1.** Solar energy to produce electricity
- 2.** Solar energy to heat water (but not for a swimming pool or hot tub)
- 3.** A wind turbine to create electricity

Don't just consider Federal standards. For example, you won't want to miss out on any state incentives. If you don't owe enough income tax to fully utilize the Federal Credits, ask your tax preparer about the possibility of carrying forward the unused portion to a future year.
